The firm was also commended in the Energy & Infrastructure Team of the Year category for its work advising sustainable UK infrastructure development company Iduna on its crowdfunding campaign to help build Greater Manchester's electric vehicle charging infrastructure.

The Lawyer Awards, which was held as a virtual ceremony on Tuesday 2 November 2021, recognises the top legal teams in the industry, celebrating innovation and best practice among private practice lawyers, senior corporate counsel, legal operations professionals, and barristers and chambers management teams.
